Fenella Rose and Ellie Knight report

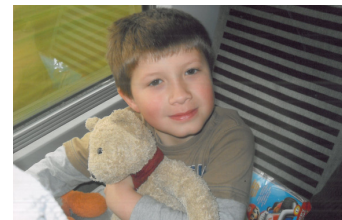
